

# TAILOR MARKER

PAT. No. 746733

With the TAILOR MARKER, basting can be done 20 times faster than by ordinary methods. It is really an ideal and indispensable article for every housewife.

## How to use

### 1. Preparation:

Have a blanket fourfolded or urethane sponge board and use it as a basting pad. Put a twofolded cloth on the pad and then lay down a pattern on the cloth.

Stick the pattern with basting needles so that it won't move during basting.

### 2. Basting:

Take a unit in right or left hand in the same way as you take a pencil. Pull out the thread about a half inch from the needle and face the cut end upward, then put needle into the full depth of the cloth. Pull out keeping finger close to where the point of the needle entered. Repeat the same action at intervals of approx. half an inch along the pattern.

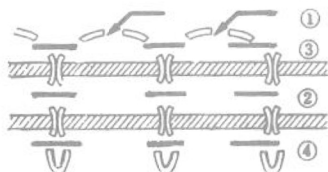
When basting is over cut the thread.

### 3. Cut the basting thread remaining in the cloth.

Remove the cloth gently from the pad and cut the thread in the following methods.

(1) cut the thread at the centre of thread mountain

(2) cut the thread between the cloths, then cut (3) and (4).



## How to supply the thread

Take the unit apart as shown in the sketch below. After the thread has been wound onto the bobbin, pass the thread through 2 to 1. On passing the thread through the needle use the threader.
